A PROCLAMATION

**DAME SUSAN DOUGAN G.C.M.G., O.B.E.,
GOVERNOR-GENERAL**

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 274 of the Laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Revised Edition, 2009 provides that the Governor-General acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may at any time, by proclamation, declare a day which is not normally a public holiday to be a Public Holiday;

NOW THEREFORE, I DAME SUSAN DOUGAN G.C.M.G., O.B.E., Governor-General of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, do hereby declare Friday the 22nd day of January, 2021 and Monday the 25th day of January, 2021 to be public holidays in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.
